

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING JOINT PURCHASING AGREEMENT
WITH MOBILE COUNTY, ALABAMA

WHEREAS, §41-16-50(b), Code of Alabama (1975) authorizes the governing bodies of two or more cities or counties to provide, by joint agreement, for the purchase of materials, equipment, supplies, equipment or other personal property for use by their respective agencies; and


WHEREAS, Mobile County, Alabama (the County) and the Town of Mt. Vernon, Alabama (the Municipality), by and through their respective governing bodies, have determined that by use of a joint purchasing agreement they may achieve economies of scale which benefit the public by decreasing the cost of materials, supplies, equipment or other personal property while increasing the efficiency of both local governments; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality desires to adopt an ordinance authorizing a joint purchasing agreement with the County; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to adopt a companion resolution authorizing a joint purchasing agreement with the Municipality;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Town of Mt. Vernon, Alabama is authorized to enter a joint purchasing agreement with Mobile County, Alabama for the purchase of the items needed for the construction and maintenance of roadways, sidewalks, parks, and like public facilities, and roadway lighting, traffic signals, lighting, traffic detention components and systems, shown on Exhibit A.


